
# YOUR DOLLARS IN ACTION

#### 100 Motorcyclists Naturalistic Study

MSF equipped participant-owned motorcycles with video cameras and data acquisition sensors to track the actions and riding environment of 100 riders over the course of a year. In the U.S. each year, riders travel over 25 billion miles and the vast majority ride safely and without incident. This naturalistic study is allowing us to learn from these riders and incorporate those findings into



MSF rider education and training programs as well as other safety countermeasures. The MSF100 Study is expected to be a rich source of insight on a range of research that will aid MSF in serving the rider community.



#### Educational Materials

Assisting in the production of educational materials on riding responsibly and the perils of riding under the influence of alcohol or drugs.


Producing and distributing rider-awareness public service announcements, seminars and videos aimed at educating car drivers on the importance of noticing motorcyclists.
